WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability is responsible for funding projects that 1 incorporate elements of sustainability such as transportation, energy, waste, climate change, 2 water, food systems, campus ecology, education and outreach; and 3 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire's mission is to "foster in one another 4 creativity, critical insight, empathy and intellectual courage, the hallmarks of a transformative 5 liberal education and the foundation for active citizenship and lifelong inquiry"; and 6 WHEREAS, a makerspace provides a platform for students of all majors and interests to 7 collaborate and innovate for creativity in a variety of fields; and 8 WHEREAS, through collaboration and reusing of tools and materials, waste is minimized 9 during the use of the makerspace, therefore aligning with goals of the Student Office of 10 Sustainability; and 11 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability in collaboration with the McIntyre Library and 12 the MakeUWEC group would work to create events, presentations and promotional materials to 13 address sustainability in the space; and 14 WHEREAS, by providing access to technology and resources, a makerspace supports the 15 university's commitment to equity and inclusivity; and 16 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability purchase equipment/tools valued at 17 \$13,119.38 and \$1,620.00 of initial materials totaling \$14,739.38. 18 WHEREAS, Attachment A outlines the makerspace proposal to the Student Office of 19 Sustainability and Attachment B outlines budgetary information 20

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, The Student Office of Sustainability Green Fund allocates \$14,739.38 to the McIntyre Library for the fulfillment of a makerspace
